Example sentences

- ① コーヒーと oucha、2つずつください。
I want two each of coffee and tea, please.
- ② A) ご注文、おきまりですか。
B) よせなべと てんぷら、1つずつ ねがひします。
A) お飲み物は?
B) ビール2つと ジュース1つ、ねがひします。
A) Are you ready to order?
B) I'd like one each of the hot pot dish and tempura please.
A) How about drinks?
B) Two beers and one juice please.

Commentary

- When saying the quantity of an object, the counter will change depending on what it is, for example, 「いちまいずつ」「いっぽんずつ」 etc.
