V-にくいです/やすいです

Used when saying that doing something is difficult or easy.

Example sentences

- **たち 新しく か おんがく 新しく 買った 音楽プレーヤーは 使い方の せつめいが わかりにくくて、こまりました。
 I was having difficulty with the explanations for using the music player I just bought because it's hard to understand.
- ② 日本製の 電気製品は こわれにくいので、長く 使えます。
 Electrical appliances made in Japan does not break down easily so you can use them for a long time.
- このれいぞうこは中が広いので、そうじしやすくて、気にいっています。I like this refrigerator because the insides are spacious so it's easy to clean.
- でんきゃ (電気屋で) (At an electrical appliance store)
 - A) この 音楽プレーヤー、どう 思いますか。
 - b) いいと 思います。機能が かんたんで、使いやすそうですね。
 - A) What do you think of this music player?
 - B) I think it's good. The features are simple and it looks easy to use.

Commentary

- · This is used for both positive and negative senses.
- Since "~やすいです" and "~にくいです" are I-adjectives, they can be used together with "~そうです" to express supposition, etc.
